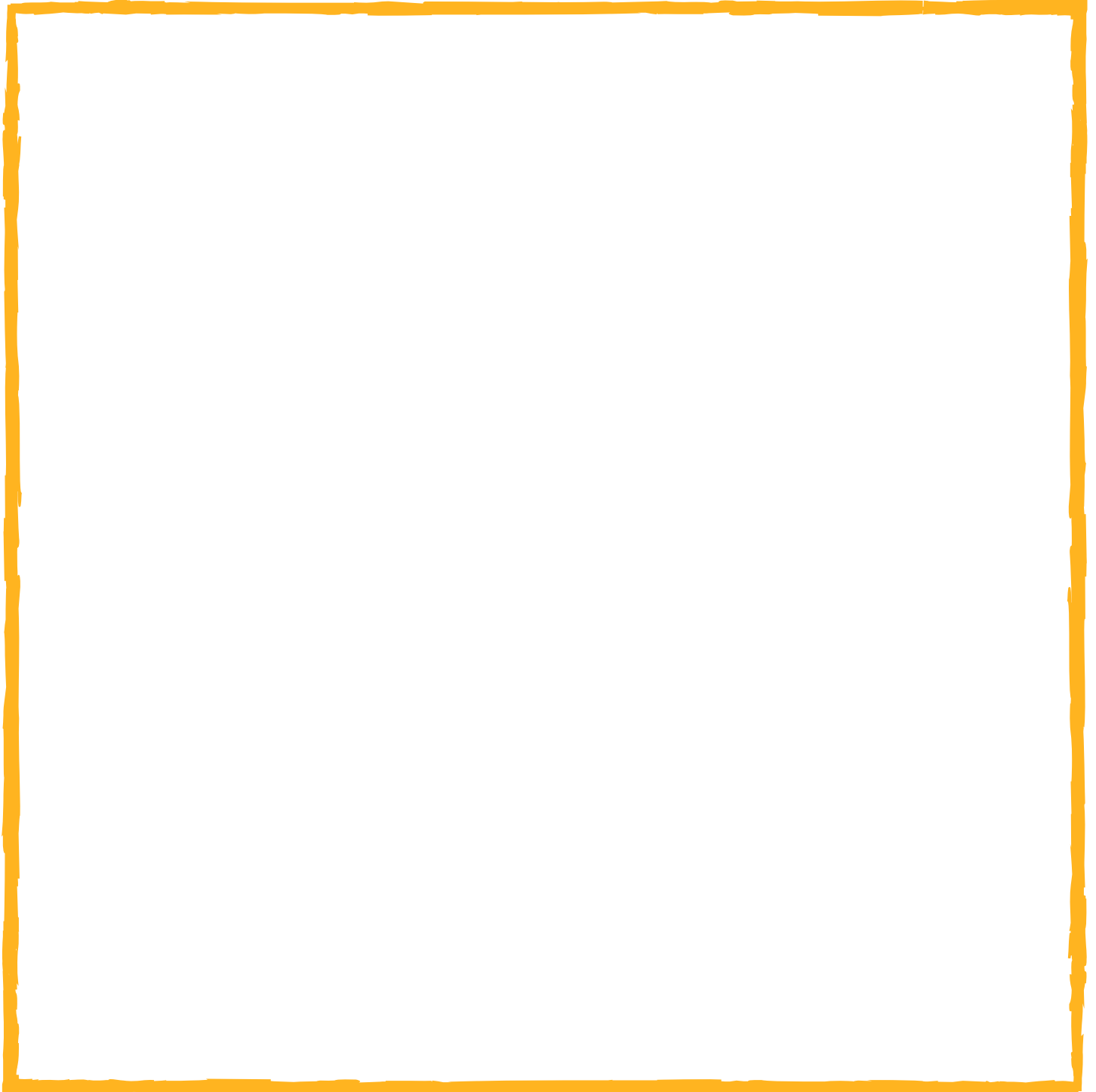


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An illustrator's job is to create pictures to enhance the text of a story. Draw a character or scene from your favorite book from the Book Fair or that you already have at home.
